

How do I know if the B11 standard I want to purchase is the most current edition?

Licensed resellers of ANSI B11 Standards can only sell current editions; archival / historical editions are only available from the B11 webstore and are clearly indicated as previous non-current editions. ANSI procedures require a consensus body review of the standards within that SDOs portfolio every five years. The SDO can choose to revise a standard (is warranted by technological advancement etc.) or simply reaffirm a document (insufficient changes since the last full revision to warrant another revision at the present time); documents that have been reaffirmed carry the original ANSI alpha-numeric designation, followed by “R” and the year of reaffirmation, in parentheses. Or the SDO occasionally decides to withdraw an ANS if there is no longer any market relevance for the particular standard (and this can be due to a variety of reasons).
